Parents always ask us “How can I find out more about what’s happening at school?”.

You can’t MAKE your child answer, but you can always ASK !

Question No. 1

“What was the best thing about school today ?”

Why was that?

What does it make you think ?

Question No. 2

“Tell me one thing you learnt today ?”

Do you like that?

Is that your favourite subject?

Question No. 3

”What’s the hardest thing you did at school ?”

So, why’s that then?

Is there anything we can do at home to help?

Question No. 4

”How are you getting on at school ?”

Who’s your best friend?

How do they find it?

Question No. 5

”What piece of work are you most proud of ?”

“Tell me more ...”

“Anything else...?”

Question No. 6

”How do you feel about school?”

Who is your favourite teacher?

ps. if they keep on saying “dunno” in response to your questions...

... just say “well if you did know the answer - ...what would it be ?”

pps. if they DO NOT want to answer.... then OK. You’re just taking an interest, you don’t need to nag them !
