Safeguarding Policy

The Big Picture has a track record in motivating students and improving exam results.

This Policy is designed to protect our business and also children who may use social media to connect with 'The Big Picture'.

In the last two years, part of our success story has been to actively engage with students after the events we've run. We've always used social media to do this (specifically Facebook & YouTube) and it has proved to be an excellent method of gaining feedback from students and also allow them to continue their 'Big Picture' journey after we've left their school. However we are conscious of harming the reputations of schools, and the feelings of students and parents who have had the opportunity to experience 'The Big Picture'. We want their experience to be as positive 'after' the event as it was during it.

Our code of conduct is as follows:

In schools with students...

- 1. Under the age of 13** – we do not promote any forms of engagement or interaction after the events.
 - A) **WE DO NOT** accept friend requests
 - B) **WE DO NOT** engage in any conversation

- 2. Aged 13 or above...** We are happy to accept friend requests and engage in conversation as long as it is positive and appropriate.

However...

 - A) **WE DO NOT engage** in any overly personal, harmful or negative chat
 - B) **WE DO NOT reciprocate** any kinds of inappropriate comments
 - C) **We will actively block** anything we consider to be not in-keeping with the positive spirit of our ethos
 - D) **WE DO NOT share** any photos or images that could be considered to be inappropriate
 - E) **WE WILL NOT** attempt to influence students or young people to think things against their own will or behave in a way that is not entirely of their own choice

Our School Rules

- We NEVER post films or material associated with the school unless given permission beforehand.
- In the unlikely event that we receive a request by any school to remove content or films between students and 'The Big Picture', this will be actioned immediately. We never question the authority of any schools who request this to happen and we totally respect their wishes. We understand that their reputation within the community is paramount when it comes to assuring parents that their child is safe in coming to their school.
